# Markets to continue the weak trend on sluggish global cues.

The market participants may get some support with thaw appearing on the GST issue, and the prospects of early roll out of GST brightening with the states and the Centre making progress on a crucial legislation, amid indications that the states may get concessions to tide over possible demonetisation-related revenue loss. The draft Bills for integrated GST and compensation as well as administrative control over businesses will be taken up for discussion on today.

The NITI Ayog vice-chairman Aravind Panagariya has termed Prime Minister Narendra Modi's demonetisation scheme as a "frontal attack" on black money and said that more such actions are in store to curb corruption.

There will be some buzz in the auto sector on reports that the Centre is looking at introducing a law where one may not be allowed to register new car or any other vehicle unless he produce proof that he has adequate parking space for it.

Edelweiss Financial Services is planning to raise Rs 600-750 crores through a public issue of its consumer lending unit, ECL Finance, according to several people close to the development.

JK Paper has decided at its meeting of Committee of Directors held on December 22, 2016, to sell 20% shareholding of OJPPL to OHC, one of the joint venture parties.

Goodluck Steel Tubes has scheduled a meeting on 27 December 2016 to issue and allot warrants convertible into equal number of equity shares to promoters on preferential basis

Igarashi Motors India has scheduled a meeting on December 26, 2016, to discuss and consider business reorganization, including amalgamation of group Company(ies), to achieve synergies in business operation.

Suzlon said it would sell a 49% stake in its special purpose vehicle (SPV) Rudra Solarfarms Ltd to Canadian solar firm AMP Solar Group for Rs14 crores, said a media report.

Welspun Enterprises announced plans to buy back up to 25% of its share capital at a price of Rs62 per equity share.

Tata Metaliks has said the amalgamation of Tata Metaliks DI Pipes with itself is effective from Thursday. Both firms are part of Tata Steel.

Sun Pharma: BofA-ML maintains buy on Sun Pharma but slashed its target price to Rs 750 from Rs 790 earlier. Odomzo acquisition to strengthen specialty portfolio, said the brokerage note.

JBM Auto has scheduled a meeting on December 29, 2016, to re-consider the proposal for various fund raising options including through Qualified Institutions Placement subject to taking of shareholders' approval.

Hinduja Ventures has approved the disinvestment of 4,36,47,056 equity shares of Rs. 10 each held by the Company in Hinduja Energy (India) Limited.

Tata Motors: The sentiments that prevailed at the Tata Motors extraordinary general meeting mirrored the EGMs at the storied group's other companies, with a majority of shareholders speaking in favour of Tata Sons' interim chairman Ratan Tata.
